DAYWISE ITENARY

Day 1 Arrival at Kuala Lumpur - Putra Jaya Tour - Fireflies Night Tour [Lunch & Dinner]

Morning Arrival at Kuala Lumpur Airport. After finishing your Immigration & Collecting your luggage, kindly refresh yourself in the Airport itself. (Bus depart from Airport at 08.30 Hrs). You will be taken to Kuala Lumpur Hotel. Enroute proceed to Putra Jaya Tour. Putrajaya is the administrative Capital of Malayasia, where you'll explore highlights like the Putrajaya Wetlands. Tour impressive and marks like Putra Mosque and Perdana Putra, the Prime Minister's office, Putrajaya Lake & Putra Bridgeas part of this tour. Afternoon Check In at Kuala Lumpur Hotel & take little rest. Later in the Evening 17.30 Hrs – Proceed to Fireflies Night Tour. Escape the hustle and bustle of Kuala Lumpur and head over the calmer and quieter hamlet town of Kuala Selangor. A trip to Kuala Selangor is incomplete without witnessing millions of mystical fireflies flashing in synchrony. Taking place after sunset, ride on a traditional boat (sampan) down the Selangor River, through the mangroves, and slowly you will see the glinting fairies welcome you in this mysterious dark night. You will never forget this amazing scene. Overnight Stay in Kuala Lumpur Hotel.

Day 2 Genting Day Trip – Batu Caves (Murugan Temple) – Watch Gallery Visit [Breakfast, Lunch & Dinner]

After morning breakfast, proceed to **Day Trip to Genting.** Genting Highlands is a high-altitude hill resort in Malaysia, situated in the Titiwangsa Mountains northeast of Kuala Lumpur. Developed since the 1960s, the site comprises hotels,





a shopping mall, restaurants and the Casino de Genting. Its Chin Swee Caves Temple sits on forested acreage with mountain views. Genting Skyway, a cable car, connects the resort with the plateau town Gohtong Jaya. Enjoy the scenic beauty of Genting Highland by travelling in Cable Car. Enroute, have a Divineful dharsan at **Batu Caves (Murugan Temple).** Evening return back to Kuala Lumpur. Overnight Stay in Kuala Lumpur Hotel.

<u>Day 3 Kuala Lumpur City Tour & Shopping [Breakfast, Lunch & Dinner]</u>

After morning breakfast, proceed to **Kuala Lumpur City Tour.** In the City tour, you would be taken to *Chinatown* for a preface to its three parallel paths, best known for street sustenance and spots of affection. By then get some answers concerning the private neighborhood of *Brick fields* while exploring the most prepared Indian settlement in KL. Stop for photo activities of the glorious screens and mounted gatekeepers at *Istana Negara*, *also called the Royal King's Palace* official residence of the pioneer of Malaysia. View the *National Monument* that commends the fallen holy people of World War I and II, by then set off for the *Perdana Botanical Garden* for a drive or stroll around the butterfly develop, winged animal stop, orchid plant, hibiscus plant and that is only the start. The park consists of three waterfront gardens: Bay South Garden, Bay East Garden and Bay Central Garden. The largest of the gardens is the Bay South Garden at 54 hectares (130 acres) designed by Grant Associates. Its Flower Dome is the largest glass greenhouse in the world. Gardens by the Bay was part of the nation's plans to transform its "Garden City" to a "City in a Garden", with the aim of raising the quality of life by enhancing greenery and flora in the city. Overnight Stay in Singapore Hotel.

<u>Day 5</u> Full Day Universal Studio & Sunset Sentosa [Breakfast, Lunch by Own & Dinner]

Today after Breakfast, Proceed to **Full Day Universal Studio.** Universal Studios Singapore is a theme park located within Resorts World Sentosa on Sentosa Island, Singapore. Its Southeast Asia's first and only Universal Studios theme park, featuring 24 rides, shows and attractions in seven themed zones. Universal Studios Singapore™, features an enticing selection of attractions, rides and entertainment for families and thrill seekers. Indeed, 18 out of the 24 movie-themed rides were designed just for the Singapore park. There are seven uniquely-designed zones, each themed after icons of the movie world. Evening 18.00 Hrs Proceed to **Sunset Sentosa with Wings of Time.** Its world's first permanent night show set in the open sea, Wings of Time features an epic production that brings together 3D projection mapping, state-of-theart laser lights, robotic water fountains and pyrotechnics to tell the tale of Shahbaz and friends. Overnight Stay in the Singapore Hotel.

<u>Day 6 Singapore City Tour – River Safari – (Optional Tour) Night Safari [Breakfast, Lunch & Dinner]</u>

Today after Breakfast, Check Out of your Room & Proceed to Half a Day Singapore City Tour. In Singapore City Tour, you will Visit the magnificent Merlion, see the Civic District, the Padang, Cricket Club, historic Parliament House, Supreme Court and City Hall. Visit one of the world's oldest Buddhist-Taoist temples, the Thian Hock Keng temple. End the tour in the incredible Little India, the centre of Singapore's Indian community. Be prepared for an assault on the senses as stalls sell incense, jasmine flowers, silk saris, dazzling metal ware and of course, spices. In the Afternoon, Proceed to Singapore River Safari. The River Safari is a river-themed zoo and aquarium located in Singapore. It is built over 12 hectares and nestled between its two counterparts, the Singapore Zoo and the Night Safari, Singapore. It is the first of its kind in Asia and features freshwater exhibits and a river boat ride as its main highlights. Later Proceed (Optional Tour) to Night Safari. The Night Safari, Singapore is the world's first nocturnal zoo located in Mandai, Singapore. One of the most popular tourist attractions in Singapore. The Night Safari currently houses over 900 animals representing over 100 species, of which 41% are threatened species. Overnight Stay in the Singapore Hotel.





<u>Day 7 Shopping – (Optional Tour) Jurong Bird Park – Jewel Changi Airport [Breakfast & Lunch]</u>

Today after Breakfast, its free for **Shopping** or you can take a Optional Tour to **Jurong Bird Park**. *Jurong Bird Park is an aviary and tourist attraction in Jurong, Singapore. The bird park, managed by Wildlife Reserves Singapore, covers an area of 0.2 square kilometres on the western slope of Jurong Hill, the highest point in the Jurong region. Evening you would dropped at Singapore Airport for your return flight to India. After Lunch at 15.00 Hrs Bus will depart to Singapore Airport for your return flight to India. If you time in Airport, you can visit Jewel Changi Airport. Jewel Changi Airport is a nature-themed entertainment and retail complex surrounded by and linked to Changi Airport, Singapore, linked to one of its passenger terminals. Its centerpiece is the world's tallest indoor waterfall, the Rain Vortex, that is surrounded by a terraced forest setting. Jewel includes gardens, attractions, a hotel, about 300 retail and dining outlets.*
